Our new employment program is designed to help you navigate the American job market, sharpen your job search and readiness skills, and connect you with self-sustaining employment that matches your skills and experiences with what employers are looking for. All this at no cost to you!!

- The opportunity to work closely with professional employment counselors
- Valuable networking possibilities with employers throughout Columbus

Our employment program, called Placement & Retention, includes five hours of in-class teaching and ten hours of outside class activities per week. It also includes five hours per week of **personalized job search assistance** with one of our dedicated employment counselors. Plus, if you complete the program and get a job, you will receive a **\$50 gas card** to help you get to work. If you are receiving public assistance (cash, food stamps, etc.) this class counts toward required hours of participation.
